



BOAT YARD RULES

-In order for us to allow do-it-yourself work in this yard, it is important that all customers work hard to keep this yard as clean and safe as possible.

-Disregarding environmental rules will result in a minimum \$250 clean up fee. Disregarding safety rules will result in the suspension of do-it-yourself privileges.

Environmental and Safety Rules:

1. You may not launch your boat if you have painted **that day!**
2. Do not move pads, stands or blocking. If you want the stands moved please notify the front counter a day in advance so we can schedule it.
3. No Wet or Dry Sanding Allowed. Westwind staff will do any sanding needed with our vacuum system. Loose paint may be removed by scraping only. All chips and debris must be swept up regularly and vacuumed at least once a day. A shop vac is available for this purpose.
4. The strap marks need to be cleaned up without dripping any water on the ground. This can be done with a wet wrung out rag and spray cleaner. Do not use a scrub brush or scrub pad. **NO WATER HOSES PERMITTED FOR THIS PURPOSE!** Dirty water can be poured on the pressure wash pad (NO Soapy Water!).
5. Washing of boat with a hose and soapy water is no longer allowed in the yard.

6. Your work area must be left clean daily. All chips and debris must be swept up.
7. Ground sheets will be provided that meet the States requirements at a charge of \$25
8. No spray painting, sand blasting or pressure washers by owners allowed.
9. No pumping of bilge, black, or gray water overboard.
10. Proper disposal of oil, antifreeze, paint residue, solvents, bilge water, etc. is the owner's responsibility.
11. Accidents will happen-please report any spills to staff IMMEDIATELY so that proper clean up measures can be taken. The \$250 minimum clean up fee will be waived if quick action can be taken. (Hourly basic labor rate will still apply and you will be billed for any cleanup supplies needed.)
12. No running engines/outboards using water hose hook-up allowed.

Owner Rules:

1. **Please do not park in the yard.**
2. All vessels must carry proper insurance.
3. Owners are responsible for scheduling launch times.
4. *All accounts must be settled prior to launch!*
5. Customers are responsible for providing their own **power cords and ladders.**
6. The shop area and tools are for employee use only. Please feel free to talk to the service manager about any problems you may encounter on your boat. We will be happy to help you.
7. Outside Contractors or any hired workers must check in at the front counter prior to performing any work in the yard or while the boat is in the travel lift. Proof of insurance and a signed copy of this form is required. A 15% surcharge on parts and labor will be paid by the contractor prior to launching the vessel.
8. Lay-day charges commence the day following a haul-out and continue till the day you launch.

Westwind Marine is not responsible for accidents, theft or vandalism of vessel or articles left in or attached to vessel, low batteries, or food spoilage.
